Introduction

When 'We' provide goods or services, we want to make them easy, useful and reliable. When services are delivered on the internet, it sometimes involves placing small amounts of information on your device, such as your computer or mobile phone. These include small files known as 'cookies'.

They cannot be used to identify you personally.

In simple terms a cookie is a small piece of information sent from our website to your device to help us recognise it quickly. If you prefer not to accept a cookie, you can navigate our websites. Any information gathered through the use of cookies is compiled on a cumulative, anonymous basis.

Agreeing to Cookies

Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but if you prefer, you should be able to change your browser to prevent that. You should read the information that came with your browser software to see if you can set up your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie. This should then give you the opportunity to decide whether you wish to accept it. However, you may not be able to take full advantage of our websites if you do not accept cookies.

Cookies are specific to the server that created them and cannot be accessed by other servers, which means they cannot be used to track your movements around the internet. If you do not change your browser settings and continue to use our websites 'We' will infer that you have consented to us using cookies for the purposes set out below.

Why we use cookies on our websites

We use cookies so that we can give you a rewarding experience when you return to our websites. In particular, 'We' use cookies to:

- Avoid lengthy registration/personalisation of the sites to suit your requirements.
- Recognise when you log-in and make it easier to access your account.
- Estimate our audience size and visitor patterns.
- Ensure you are not trying to register twice.
- Track preferences and improve and update our websites.
